Mount A student wins at Atlantic conference

Mount Allison geography student Nigel Selig has won a second conference presentation award.

The Bridgewater, N.S., resident collected a trophy for best overall presentation at the 17th annual Atlantic Division of the Canadian Association of Geographers (ACAG) Conference in St. John's, NL. Selig competed in an open forum against undergraduate, Master's and Ph.D. students to win the award. This is the fourth time that a Mount Allison student has won the award since its inception.

Selig presented results from a project he carried out under the guidance of André Robichaud and Colin Laroque in the geography department. His presentation highlighted results of a dendroarchaeology investigation of the construction of *Dorchester House* in *Dorchester, N.B.*

Dendroarchaeology involves the use of tree rings to determine the age of wood in a historical structure. Selig was able to determine when specific parts of the house were constructed, renovated, and added to. By establishing this timeline, he was then able to search historical documents to determine the likely builder of each component of the house.
